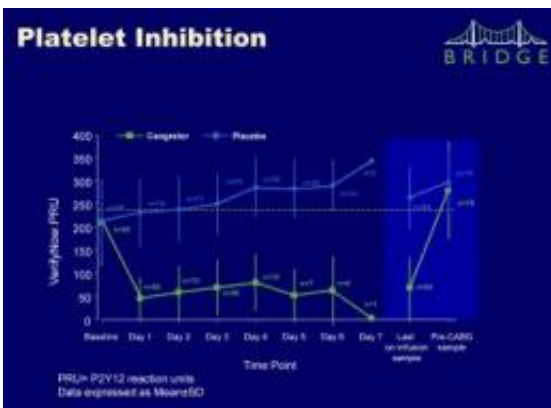


Results of the BRIDGE trial reported at TCT 2011

The first stage of BRIDGE identified the cangrelor dose that maintains a "thienopyridine-like" level of platelet inhibition. The second stage reported today was a prospective, randomized, double-blind, placebo-controlled trial in 210 patients with an acute coronary syndromes (ACS) or treated with a coronary stent (bare metal stent or drug eluting stent) on a thienopyridine awaiting coronary artery bypass grafting (CABG).
