

ASCO issues guideline for febrile neutropenia in adults

Christopher R. Flowers, M.D., from Emory University in Atlanta, and colleagues conducted a literature review and identified 43 studies assessing development of fever and/or infections in afebrile neutropenic outpatients with cancer, or treatment of fever and <u>neutropenia</u> in



outpatients with cancer. Data extracted from the studies were used to inform guidelines.

The <u>expert panel</u> recommends that antibacterial and antifungal prophylaxis should only be used for patients expected to have
