

Legal claims rising for laser surgery by nonphysicians

(HealthDay)—Legal claims related to cutaneous laser surgery performed by nonphysician operators (NPOs) are increasing, according to research published in the April issue of *JAMA Dermatology*.

H. Ray Jalian, M.D., from the University of California in Los Angeles, and colleagues utilized an online national database of public legal documents to identify cases involving <u>laser surgery</u> by NPOs.



procedures are performed by NPOs. Most NPO cases (64.0 percent) were performed outside of a traditional medical setting.

"Physicians and other laser operators should be aware of their state laws, especially in regard to physician supervision of NPOs," the authors write.
