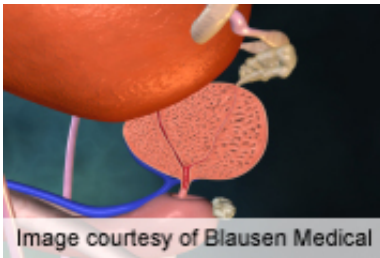


# PSA rise with testosterone gel tied to specific factors
