

Celecoxib safe, effective for brucellosisassociated depression

(HealthDay)—Celecoxib seems safe and effective for treatment of depression due to acute brucellosis, according to a study published online May 26 in the *Journal of Clinical Pharmacy and Therapeutics*.

Sara Jafari, M.D., from the Tehran University of Medical Sciences in Iran, and <u>colleagues</u> conducted a <u>randomized trial</u> involving 40 outpatients with depression due to brucellosis with a Hamilton Depression Rating Scale score (HDRS)
