The coronavirus pandemic in Germany is "again under control" thanks to a month of lockdown imposed after an early surge in cases, Health Minister Jens Spahn said Friday.

The <u>restrictions</u> to keep people home "was successful," Spahn told reporters in Berlin. "The infection numbers have sunk significantly,



especially the relative day-by-day number. The outbreak is today again under control."
