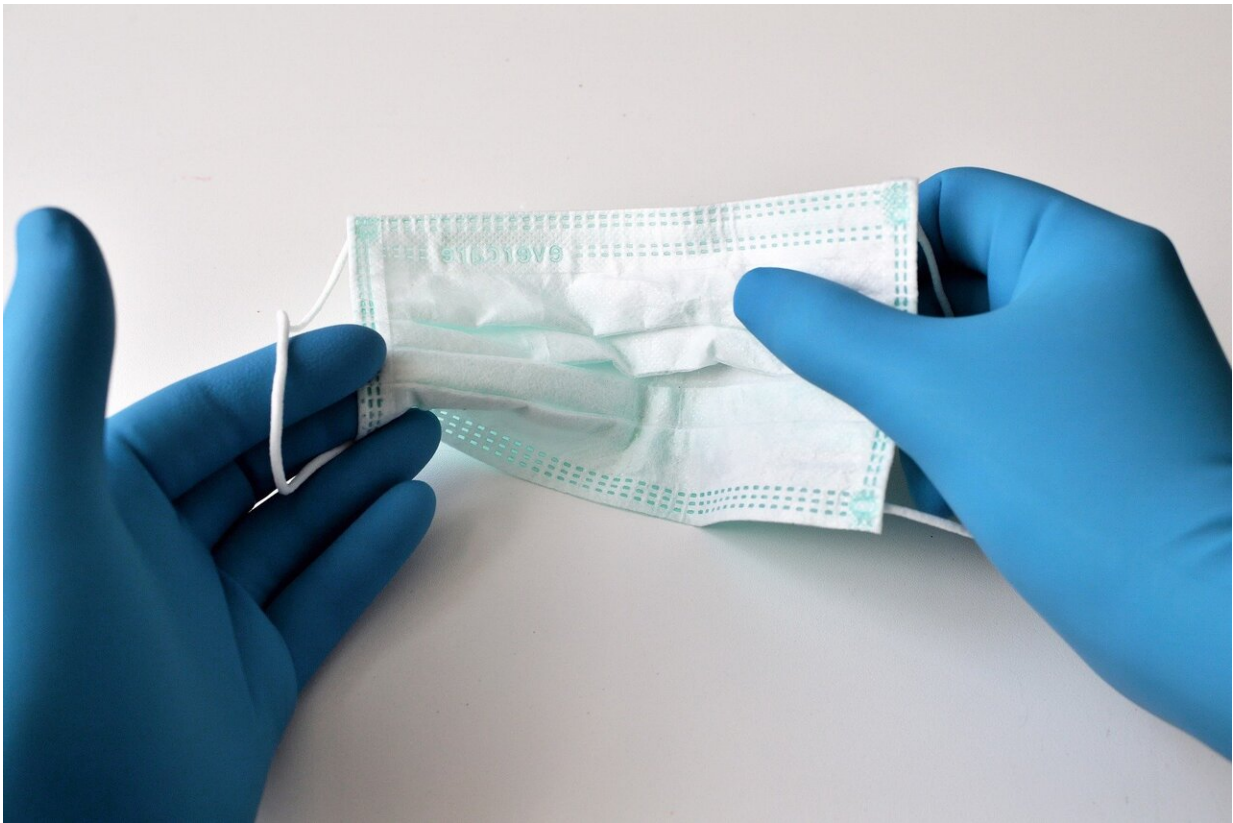


Video: Here's why a COVID-19 vaccine may not be enough
