

More radiologists participating in MSSP ACOs

From 2013 to 2018, there was a more than threefold increase in



radiologist participation in Medicare Shared Savings Program (MSSP) accountable care organizations (ACOs), according to a study published online May 19 in the *Journal of the American College of Radiology*.

Stefan Santavicca, from the Georgia Institute of Technology in Atlanta, and colleagues characterized <u>radiologist</u> participation in MSSP ACOs from 2013 to 2018.

The researchers found an increase in the percentage of Medicare-participating radiologists affiliated with MSSP ACOs, from 10.4 percent in 2013 to 34.9 percent in 2018. The share of large ACOs (>20,000 beneficiaries) with participating radiologists averaged 87.0 percent during that time, while increases were seen in the shares of medium ACOs (10,000 to 20,000) and small ACOs (
