

Enterovirus D68 detections lower than expected in 2020

(HealthDay)—Enterovirus D68 (EV-D68) detections were lower than



anticipated in 2020, according to research published in the Nov. 24 issue of the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention *Morbidity and Mortality Weekly Report*.
