

Kraft recalls powdered drinks over metal, glass concerns

(HealthDay)—Kraft Heinz Co. announced that it is recalling certain lots

of Country Time Lemonade, Tang, Arizona Tea and Kool-Aid powdered drinks because they may contain small pieces of metal or glass.

The company also [said](#) that certain lots of Country Time Lemonade with "Best When Used By" date of September 15, 2023 and Tang powdered drinks with "Best When Used By" dates of Aug. 20-21, 2023, have been recalled in Canada for the same issue.

The problem with the glass and metal pieces occurred during production the [company](#) said.

The [recalled products](#), which include "Best When Used By" dates between May 10, 2023, and Nov. 1, 2023, should be thrown away or returned to the place of purchase for a refund.
