A <u>review</u> in The Lancet evaluates the three major methods for the detection of SARS-CoV-2 infection and their role in managing the pandemic. This infographic provides a visual overview of the strengths and weaknesses of molecular (PCR), antigen (<u>lateral flow</u>), and serology (antibody) tests, and summarizes guidance on their effective use in different settings.

All three types of COVID-19 test continue to have a crucial role in the transition from pandemic response to pandemic control.
