

Day care tied to morbidity in children born preterm with BPD

For children born preterm with bronchopulmonary dysplasia (BPD),



those attending day care have increased likelihood of emergency department visits and systemic steroid usage, according to a study published online July 5 in *The Journal of Pediatrics*.

Sharon A. McGrath-Morrow, M.D., from the Children's Hospital of Philadelphia, and colleagues obtained <u>day care</u> attendance and <u>clinical outcomes</u> via standardized instruments for 341 individuals recruited from nine BPD specialty clinics. All individuals were former preterm infants (
