

Many females receiving HPV vaccination after recommended age

Many females receive human papillomavirus (HPV) vaccination after



the recommended ages, often after sexual debut, according to a research letter published online Oct. 21 in *JAMA Network Open*.

Didem Egemen, Ph.D., from the National Institutes of Health in Bethesda, Maryland, and colleagues used data from the National Health and Nutrition Examination Survey to estimate the proportion of <u>females</u> who were vaccinated before sexual debut and examined the association of delayed vaccination with the prevalence of HPV-16/18.

The researchers found that the prevalence of cervical HPV-16/18 decreased from 6 percent in the unvaccinated group to 3 percent in the postdebut group and
