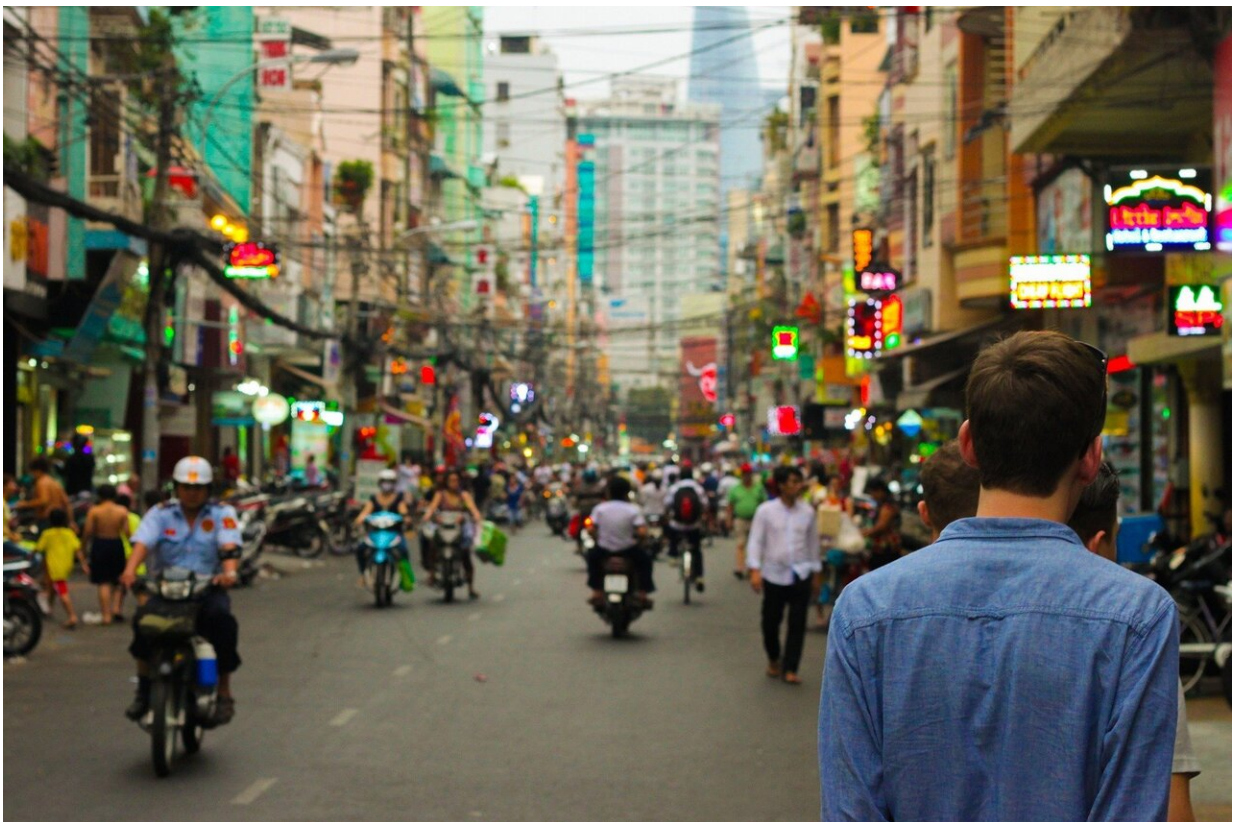


Changes to the diagnosis and treatment of COVID-19 in China throughout the pandemic

An article in [*Health Care Science*](#) provides an in-depth analysis of the changes made to the diagnosis and treatment protocol for COVID-19 in

China over the course of the pandemic.

The authors compare and summarize each of the 10 versions of the protocol issued by the National Health Commission of China over 3 years, highlighting the evolving [scientific evidence](#) and disease situation that informed these changes.

The summary provides [valuable insights](#) into the adaptive healthcare management and response to COVID-19 in China, which can inform the global response to the pandemic.

"Clinical management of emerging diseases requires constant adaptation. This review highlights China's evidence-based approach to refining diagnosis, treatment, and care protocols over time, demonstrating how these changes have effectively combated the challenges of COVID-19," said co-corresponding author You Wu, Ph.D., of Tsinghua University.
