

## Gaps seen in childhood vision screening and vision care

Gaps in access to childhood vision screening and vision care are prevalent among historically marginalized racial and ethnic groups and socioeconomically vulnerable families, according to a research letter <a href="mailto:published">published</a> online in *JAMA Ophthalmology*.

Isdin Oke, M.D., from Boston Children's Hospital, and colleagues sought to identify gaps in the vision screening pathways for U.S. children. The analysis included data from 30,173 <u>school-aged children</u> (aged six to
