

Possible contamination with 'rubber pieces' prompts sausage recall

More than 35,000 pounds of Johnsonville turkey kielbasa sausages are under recall due to possible contamination with "pieces of rubber."

Denmark, Wisconsin-based Salm Partners, which makes the sausage, said the products under recall were made Oct 30 and 31 and shipped to retailers nationwide.



They carry <u>labels</u> reading Johnsonville POLISH KIELBASA TURKEY sausage, and have best before dates of "05/17/24" and "05/18/24" printed on the sides of the plastic packaging. Recalled products also bear the establishment number stamp of "P-32009" on the packaging.

According to a news release from the U.S. Department of Agriculture Food Safety & Inspection Service (FSIS), so far there "have been no confirmed reports of adverse reactions or injury due to consumption of these <u>products</u>."

The FSIS urges anyone who finds the recalled sausages in their refrigerators to throw them out or return them to where they were purchased.
