

# Preeclampsia linked to increased risk for young-onset dementia

Individuals with preeclampsia have an increased risk for young-onset dementia, according to a [research letter](#) published online May 30 in *JAMA Network Open*.

Valérie Olié, Ph.D., from Santé Publique in Saint-Maurice, France, and colleagues obtained [data](#) from the nationwide prospective Conception study, which included all [deliveries](#) in France after 22 weeks of gestation between Jan. 1, 2010, and Dec. 31, 2018.

Individuals aged 30 years or older without a history of dementia were identified and followed from delivery to Dec. 31, 2021; the analyses included 1,966,323 [individuals](#),
