

Program can prevent adverse childhood experiences in Indigenous children

A seven-session program that teaches skills to prevent adverse childhood experiences (ACEs) in a largely Indigenous population shows promise for preventing ACEs, according to a study [published](#) online Aug. 13 in

Pediatrics.

Katie M. Edwards, Ph.D., from the University of Nebraska in Lincoln, and colleagues randomly assigned 124 families (96% Indigenous; 90% with yearly income
